Phase 1 Scope of Work

- Collect available physical and environmental data.
- Review inventory of existing transient mooring facilities to identify vessel type, mix, and location.
- Meet with Town representatives to discuss vessel traffic considerations and transient boat operations.
- Define boundaries of mooring field
- Identify opportunity and constraints including phasing
- Final memorandum with graphic and Class 5 Cost Estimate




Next Phases

- Perform field investigations (geotechnical, bathymetric/benthic surveys)
- Refine concept and prepare 30% level construction document/cost estimate to support permitting and grant applications.
- Meet with USACE to discuss potential Federal Channel Relocation
- Submit permit and grant applications (potential Section 408?)
- Prepare bid documents for competitive bidding




Existing Conditions





Potential Layout









