
Topsail Park



- The P&R Committee is exploring other possible donations for items such as benches, picnic tables, grills, shade sails and would like to engage local Civic Organizations.



- Staff has explored grant options to include CAMA and Part F. We have been advised to look at applying in the future after the property has been transferred to the Town.
- Staff is investigating partnerships for educational elements for natural plantings

Derwood's Landing/Cedar Street

Gallants Landing Owners Association Proposal:

 Will pay for new dock and kayak launch on north side of Cedar Street Park in exchange for ownership of Derwood's Landing.

Considerations:

- Cedar Street Park does not feature a kayak/boat dock due to safety concerns with the currents in the area.
- P&R Board is not in favor of the proposal although they have not officially reviewed it.
- Proposed location interferes with traditional fishing area
