Community Rating System (CRS)

- Voluntary program
- Rewards communities for exceeding minimum standards of the National Flood Insurance Program
- Point-based scoring system

SFHA: Zones A, AE, A1–A30, V, V1–V30, AO, and AH

Outside the SFHA: Zones X, B, C, A99, AR, and D

Preferred Risk Policies are not eligible for CRS premium discounts because they already have premiums lower than other policies. Preferred Risk Policies are available only in B, C, and X Zones for properties that are shown to have a minimal risk of flood damage.

Some minus-rated policies may not be eligible for CRS premium discounts.

Premium discounts are subject to change.


Current Standards

Height Measurement

 Adjacent naturally occurrent grade to the peak of the roof
