# Items for Review and Approval

## 1. Human Resources Officer Position

- Moved from SG 25 (\$66,160) to SG 22 (\$57,151)
- Part Time (4 hours/day, 5 days/week)
  - Recruit for 2 Months
- If Unsuccessful, Position Automatically Converts to Full Time

# **Items for Review and Approval**

## **2. Storm Water Outfall Contamination Analysis**

- Follow-Up to Previous Research
- Performed by the Noble Lab, UNC-IMS
- Town Creek Outfall Analysis: \$36,000
- Orange St. Outfall Review: \$6,200

# Items for Review and Approval

## 3. American Recovery Plan Funding

- Water Treatment Plant Site Evaluation and Purchase – FY22
  - \$500K
- Sewer Pump Station #7 – FY22/FY23
  - \$740K
- Miscellaneous Storm Water Work – FY22
  - \$60K

# Items for Review and Approval

## 4. Miscellaneous Changes

### CIP:

- Fire Station 2 Living Quarters move from FY23 to FY22
- Fire Station 2 Pumper Truck debt service moves from FY23 to FY22
- Water Treatment Plant – testing and purchase of well sites changes to obtaining purchase options in FY22; preliminary planning moves to out years

# Items for Review and Approval

## 4. Miscellaneous Changes

### Five Year Plan:

- Add PD body cameras annual cost beginning FY23: \$17,500
- Add filter media replacement cost for WWTP deodorizer in FY26: \$50,000
- Fire Station 2 maintenance, firefighter positions/gear move from FY22 to FY23
- Fire Station 2 truck debt/living qtrs. move from FY 23 to FY22
- Increase residential solid waste revenues and expenses by \$10,000 in FY22 and beyond

# Items for Review and Approval

## 4. Miscellaneous Changes

### Annual Budget:

- Increase residential solid waste revenues and expenses by \$10,000
- Add Fire Station 2 truck debt and living qtrs.
- Remove Fire Station 2 maintenance, firefighter positions/gear move from FY22



# Item for Review

## Solid Waste Fees

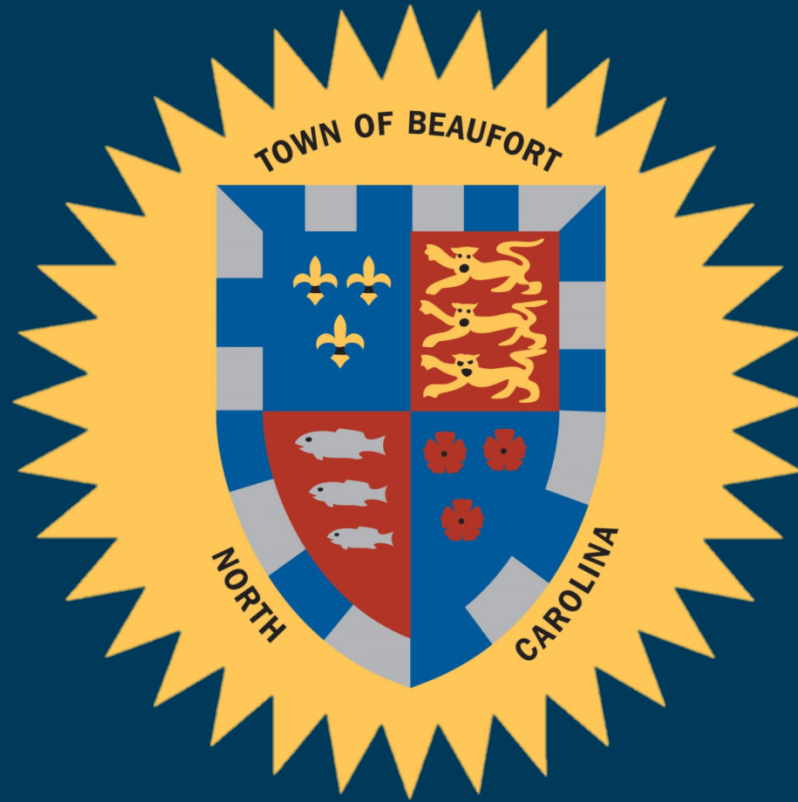
### Residential:

- Revenue falls \$11,000 short of covering costs
- Shortfall is absorbed without fee increase

### Waterfront Business District:

- Revenue falls \$49,000 short of covering costs
- Shortfall is absorbed without fee increase
