

STATE OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION TOWN OF BEAUFORT, NORTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS, Governor Roy Cooper declared a State of Emergency for North Carolina on July 31, 2020, in anticipation of damage from Hurricane Isaias; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the above-described emergency, I have determined that there is an imminent threat of, or existing conditions have caused or will cause, widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property, and public safety authorities will be unable to maintain public order or afford adequate protection for lives or property; and

WHEREAS, declaring a State of Emergency and imposing the restrictions and prohibitions ordered herein is necessary to maintain order and protect public health, safety, and welfare, and to secure property.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as the Mayor of the Town of Beaufort under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Chapter 33 of the Town of Beaufort Code of Ordinances:

Section 1. A State of Emergency is hereby declared within the Town of Beaufort as more particularly described in Section 2.
